Recueil des Synodes Nationaux des Eglises Réformées de France 1623-1659

Binding:

Original, French style, from the same period as the manuscript, made of brown leather, with ornaments and gilded inscriptions.

History:

This copy was made after 1681 in France, in the environment of French Protestants with whom it reached Germany. Earlier pressmarks (probably from the first collection): 6. B. The manuscript reached the Königlische Bibliothek in Berlin before 1828.

Content:

RECUEIL DES SYNODES NATIONAUX DES EGLISES REFORMEES DE FRANCE 1623-1659. Copies of the files of the synods of French Protestant churches. It is the second volume of a larger work in which manuscript gall. fol. 122 constitutes the first volume. The texts are preserved in the manuscripts of the Bibliothèque Publique et Universitaire de Genève, fr. 41, 43, 45, 46, 48, 49, 51 (cf. *Bibliothèque de Genève, catalogue des Manuscrits français (1-198)*, Genève 2009).
