Binding:

Half-binding: brown leather and marbled paper, made at the Königliche Bibliothek in Berlin: the manuscript was submitted for binding on 27th February 1880.

History:

Writing has some features characteristic of seventeenth-century writing. Considering the fact that one of the texts was published in 1655, the manuscript was made in France, in the 17th century, after 1655. There are no clues as to how the manuscript reached Germany. It was bought from T. O. Weigel, an antiquarian from Leipzig and registered in the accession register of the Königliche Bibliothek in Berlin on 27th February 1880.

Content:

The manuscript contains several texts written in the Gallican spirit and dating from the same period, around the middle of the 17th century:

I (1r^o-22r^o) anonymous author: *Differends ecclesiastiques arrivez tant entre les Papes et les Roys de France, que le Clergé de leur Royaume*. This work was published in Paris, in 1645.

II (23r^o-33r^o) Petrus de Marca : *Examen de la Bulle sur la Residence des Cardinaux, pour faire voir que le Roy en peut retenir en ses Conseils, qui par consequent seront dispensez de Residence à Rome*. III (35r^o-39v^o) Pierre Dupuy (?): *Projet de Declaration du Roy en faveur des Cardinaux Barberin et autres contre la Bulle du Pape touchant la Residence des Cardinaux*. With reference to the events described in this work cf. l' « Histoire générale et raisonnée de la diplomatie française ... » par M. de Flassan, tome troisième, Paris 1809, pp. 102-104.

IV (41r^o-46v^o) Pierre Dupuy : *Examen de la Bulle du Pape touchant la Residence des Cardinaux*.

V (47r^o-102v^o) Simon Vigor / Pierre Dupuy (?): *Histoire du differend entre le pape Boniface VIII et le roy Philippe le Bel*. This work was published in Paris, in 1655.

VI (105r^o-210v^o) Pierre Dupuy : *Que le Roy de sa seule auctorité peut, en cas de necessité, tirer des contributions des Ecclesiastiques*. This memorial was written either in 1639 or 1640.
