## Binding:

20<sup>th</sup>-century halfbinding (248 × 175 mm), covered with Bordeaux fabric. A grey envelope glued on the inside cover.

## History:

Dating based on the writing. 14<sup>th</sup> century (*terminus post quem*: 1333, i.e. the date of the creation of the text). Various inscriptions in the manuscript refer to a book, from whose binding the Ital. Quart. 82 manuscript was separated in 1922 (pressmark Fq 29650 – Andrzej Lipski, *Decas quaestionum publicarum regni, in quibus ecclesiastica iura, et immunitates ecclesiastici status elucidantur*, Posnaniae 1626). The binding of the manuscript was made after 1822 in the Königliche Bibliothek. Accession number: *Acc.ms.1922.88.1* 

## Content:

ff. 1r°-2v° Simone Fidati da Cascia - Ordine della Vita Cristiana, fragment. Two cards, badly damaged, come from a manuscript containting the text *Ordine della Vita Cristiana* by Simone Fidati da Cascia. Published in *Mistici del Duecento e del Trecento*, ed. Arrigo Levasti, Milano-Roma, Rizzoli, 1935, pp. 607-80. Two cards (nonconsecutive) corresponds to fragments from part II, chapters 1 and 2. The present order of the cards is erroneous, since in the manuscript card 2 was surely before card 1. The manuscript version is significantly different from the published text.
