The conference will be organized by the Department of Japanology and Sinology at the Jagiellonian University and the Manggha Museum of Japanese Art and Technology in Krakow. It will take place on 14-17 November 2013 in Krakow.

The Conference will cover a vast range of topics including history and social studies, language and literature, culture and arts. We welcome papers and panel proposals that address various problems of how Japanese civilization has been manifested and realized from the ancient times till the present day. We also welcome proposals addressing Japan’s social and political challenges posed by dynamic changes in contemporary Asia.

The conference language is English and Japanese.

The conference fee is 100 PLN (approx. 25 EUR).
